

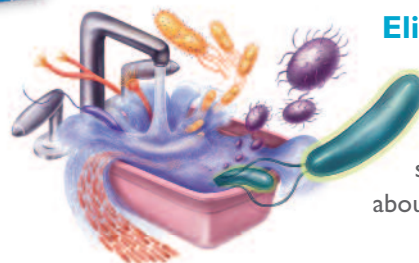

ADDRESS CMS REIMBURSEMENT MANDATES

As of October 1, 2008, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services no longer reimburse hospitals for pressure ulcers not present on admission.³

Comfort Bath with Skin Check™ helps promote skin cleansing, observation, recording, communication and rapid response by the nursing staff.

One study presented at IHI's 2006 National Forum on Quality Improvement in Healthcare hospitals the use of Skin Check reduced the rate of hospital-acquired pressure ulcers from 18.00% to 5.88% over a three-month period.⁴

IHI "5 MILLION LIVES" CAMPAIGN⁵

IHI states that skin should be inspected daily, "as skin integrity may deteriorate in a matter of hours..." Processes that "can be put in place to ensure daily inspection of the skin" include:

- ▶ "Adapt documentation tools to prompt daily skin inspection, documentation of findings, and initiation of prevention strategies as needed."
- ▶ "Educate all levels of staff to inspect the skin any time they are assisting the patient, for example...while bathing. Upon recognition of any change in skin integrity, notify staff so that appropriate interventions can be put in place."

JCAHO 2007 NATIONAL PATIENT SAFETY GOALS⁶

From JCAHO's 2007 National Patient Safety Goals for Hospitals and Critical Access Hospitals:

Goal 2: Improve the effectiveness of communication among caregivers.

- 2C "Measure, assess and, if appropriate, take action to improve the timeliness of reporting, and the timeliness of receipt by the responsible licensed caregiver, of critical test results and values."
- 2E "Implement a standardized approach to 'hand off' communications, including an opportunity to ask and respond to questions."
